

Cisco College Board of Regents
Special Called Meeting
August 26, 2020

The Cisco College Board of Regents met Wednesday, August 26, 2020, in the Harrell Fine Arts Building – Room 215, on the college main campus in Cisco, Texas. Officers in attendance were President Brad Kimbrough and Vice President Ronnie Ledbetter. Regents present were Matt Johnson, Jerry Conring, Sharon Wilcoxon, Staci Wilks and Greg Cary. Secretary Ricky Whatley and Regent Joe Jarvis were absent. College administrators present were Dr. Thad J. Anglin, President and Audra Taylor, Chief Financial Officer and Dean of Business Services. Sydni Rabb, Executive Assistant, was present.

Guest present at the meeting was Roger Tighe, Cisco College Chief of Police.

Regent Staci Wilks offered the invocation.

President Brad Kimbrough called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

The Board of Regents of Cisco College has heretofore given public notices and conducted such votes as are necessary for the adoption of an ad valorem tax rate for the 2020-2021 tax year as required by Chapter 26, of the Texas Property Tax Code; and they find it to be in the public interest to adopt an ad valorem tax as described: The Cisco College Tax District shall impose an ad valorem tax of all taxable property within its boundaries of \$.2080 per \$100 of valuation of such property for the 2020-2021 tax year to be imposed pursuant to the terms and requirements of the Constitution of the State of Texas and the Texas Property Tax Code and said tax begin so levied and apportioned to the specific purpose herein set forth. On a motion by Regent Wilks and a second by Regent Ledbetter, the board voted to approve Resolution 2020-004, Resolution Adopting Tax Rate for 2020-2021, as presented. Motion passed 6 – 0, with Regents Whatley and Jarvis absent.

President, Dr. Thad Anglin, reported that there had been a few resignations announced since the last meeting. These included Tori Creamer, Admissions Specialist – Abilene Campus and William Dailey, Professor of HVAC. There were no retirements, terminations or recommendations for part-time personnel. Recommendations for full-time employment included that of Jimmy Waddington, Professor of HVAC and Jon Stenman, Head Women's Volleyball Coach. There were no other personnel matters and on a motion by Regent Jerry Conring and a second by Regent Sharon Wilcoxon, the board voted to accept the resignations and recommendations of full-time employment, as presented. Motion passed 6 – 0, with Regents Whatley and Jarvis absent.

Under Remarks by the President, Dr. Thad Anglin, classes began on Monday, August 17th, we are continuing to register until Monday, August 31st. We are currently down 15% as of yesterday. We will have certified numbers at the next meeting.

In Remarks by Board Members, there were none.

The next board meeting is September 14, 2020.


President Kimbrough entertained a motion to adjourn. Regents Wilcoxon and Wilks obliged with a motion and second, respectively. Motion carried.
