

## CISCO COLLEGE

### CREDIT BY EXAMINATION – CLEP/AP/IB

Cisco College recognizes credit by examination for the College Level Examination Program (CLEP), the Advance Placement Program (AP) and the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IB). Students that score high enough on select exams may receive credit for coursework at Cisco College. Other institutions have varying policies on accepting credit by examination so a student wishing to transfer this credit to another institution needs to check with that institution regarding their policy.

Requirements to receive credit;

- A student must enroll for a semester at Cisco College or have been previously enrolled at Cisco College for a semester before credit can be awarded on a transcript.
- Cisco College must receive an official score report.
- The student must make a formal request through the Counseling Office to receive credit.
- Credit may not be awarded for a course the student has previously attempted.
- Credit by examination will not count towards the residency requirement for a degree.
- Credit by examination is recorded as credit only and not as a grade. Therefore, it does not count into a student's grade point average.
