MATH: THEA 230; Accuplacer Elem Algebra 63; Compass Algebra 39; Asset Elem Algebra 38, or a grade of A or B in College Algebra taken within the last 5 years of date of application to the Teacher Education Program at McM.

WRITING: THEA 240; Accuplacer Sentence Skills 80 & Written Essay 6; Compass Writing Skills 59 w/ Written Essay 6; Asset Writing Skills 40 w/ Written Essay 5, or a grade of A or B taken within the last 5 years of date of application to the Teacher Education Program at McM.
