

## Request for Hazlewood Exemption

### Please read carefully

***At this time, you may apply for exemption for Summer 2016 - Fall 2017 & spring 2018. Only apply for the semesters you plan to enroll. Read [TVC website](#) for more information.***

- You must meet eligibility requirements to receive [Hazlewood tuition exemption](#).
- Your deadline to apply for Hazlewood is the last class day of the semester for which you are requesting exemption. It is preferable that you apply prior to the census date (12th class day in the fall and spring, 4th class day in the summer)
- You must be enrolled in the current term deposit before you apply. If you are not been enrolled, eligibility will not be determined, and the forms will not be retained. Please note that Hazlewood exemption only applies to classes for which the College receives state support.
- If you are applying for Hazlewood for the first time at Cisco College, you must complete
  - TVC-ED-1: [Texas Hazlewood Act Exemption Application](#)
  - Statement of Understanding
- You must specify the semester(s) for which you are applying for exemption, including each semester and year.  
Example: "Summer 2016, Fall 2016, Spring 2017".
- Packets must be complete and submitted only once with all supporting documents as indicated. Significant delays are possible if applications are incomplete.

- Late registration fees are not covered by this exemption.

**DISCLAIMER:** Although your exemption may be processed prior to the end of a semester, we will periodically reevaluate your eligibility to ensure that you still qualify for the exemption. We reserve the right to deny your request for a particular semester if we determine that you are not eligible for that semester. Eligibility may change based on age or satisfactory academic progress (as outlined by the Office of Student Financial Services), loan default status, changes to the law, or other factors.
