What your Students and Advisors Need to Know

Students who successfully complete WECM/AAS courses in specifically applied science degrees may petition for a limited number of elective credit hours to be awarded after admission to UT Dallas (please see the attached list of approved courses). More information on the admission process and steps to take to register and receive credit are listed below:

1. Follow the [steps to apply as a transfer student](#). After you submit your application through [ApplyTexas](#) and have provided your required documents, your application will be considered complete and ready for review. Select only GIS, Criminology, or Public Affairs (Public and Nonprofit Management) as your major choice on Apply Texas as these are the only majors currently accepting specific applied science (WECM) credit.
2. The admission office will review your entire completed application file before rendering an admission decision. You are encouraged to submit your documents early. You can check on your [application status](#) or any missing documentation in the [Orion Applicant Center](#) inside Galaxy.
3. Once an admission decision is made, your application status will be updated in your [Orion Applicant Center](#) in Galaxy. You will receive a decision letter both through mail and email.
4. After admission, you will need to complete the [steps after admission for transfer students](#) before you can register for classes.
5. Students can petition to receive credit for WECM/AAS related courses as outlined on our website at: <https://registrar.utdallas.edu/transfer-credit/workforce-credit/> (see attached for a complete list of courses)
