Cisco College Welcomes Dr. Tim Murphy as New Executive Director of IT

Dr. Murphy joins Cisco College through George Mason University in Fairfax, Va., where he was the Director of Classroom and Lab Technologies, Enterprise Infrastructure. Murphy was responsible for all university classroom and lab support, Admissions Welcome Center, library technology spaces, and conference and meeting room technology supporting more than 70,000 users.

Murphy has extensive experience in IT management including enterprise-level systems, strategic foresight and planning, active learning classroom technology, digital media support, as well as project management and grant writing.

Murphy's education credentials include a master's degree and doctorate in instructional technology from the University of Houston. He returned to University of Houston in 2016 to complete a second master's in Strategic Foresight, graduating in 2020.

"Dr. Murphy has extensive experience in higher education as a technician and manager over IT Departments," he said.
