

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-002

FROM CISCO COLLEGE: CRIMINAL JUSTICE GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, Cisco College finds it in the best interest of the students of Cisco College that the Criminal Justice Grant Program be operated for October 1, 2026, until September 30, 2027; and

WHEREAS, Cisco College will use the grant funding to revise and broaden the Criminal Justice Program Curriculum and educational materials; and

WHEREAS, Cisco College agrees to provide applicable matching funds (no matching funds required for Criminal Justice Grant) for the said project as required by the grant application Criminal Justice Grant Program, FY 2027; and


WHEREAS, Cisco College agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds, Cisco College assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full.

WHEREAS, Cisco College designates Heather McClure, Vice President of Instruction as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

WHEREAS, Cisco College designates Audra Taylor, Chief Financial Officer, as the grantee's financial officer. The financial officer is given the power to submit financial and/or programmatic reports or alter a grant on behalf of the applicant agency. Reporting and correspondence, but not alteration to the grant, may be handled by Dr. Helen Usera, Director of Development and Grants, and Beverly Massey, Director of Operations, Procurement & Grant Accountant.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Cisco College approves submission of the grant application for the Criminal Justice Grant Program, FY 2027 to the Office of the Governor.
