STEP 1



Eligibility Standards

To be eligible for the ASES program, students must be low-income, have a demonstrable academic ability or potential, be U.S. citizens, U.S. nationals, permanent residents, or officially admitted refugees, and be enrolled at least half-time in ASU. ASU's Financial Aid Office classifies a student as "low-income" if they are eligible for the Federal Pell Grant.

STEP 2



Scholarship Amounts

The scholarship amounts have been set at \$8,000 per student per year. Actual scholarship amounts awarded will vary based on each recipient's unmet need, but will not exceed the \$10,000 cap per year.

4 year scholarship for new first time students
2.5 years scholarship for transfer students
