

Cisco College Board of Regents
2nd Tax Rate Public Hearing
September 4, 2019

The Cisco College Board of Regents met Wednesday, September 4, 2019, in the Board Room of the Regents' House on the college main campus in Cisco, Texas. Regents present were Brad Kimbrough – President, Ronnie Ledbetter – Vice President, Jerry Conring, Sharon Wilcoxon, Joe Jarvis and Greg Cary. Secretary Ricky Whatley, Matt Johnson and Staci Wilks were absent. Administrator present was President, Dr. Thad J. Anglin. Recording Secretary, Sydni Rabb, was present.

Regent Joe Jarvis offered the invocation.

President Kimbrough called the meeting and public hearing to order at 6:00 p.m.

There were no citizens present, therefore, no public comments.

College President, Dr. Thad Anglin, read the required statement giving information regarding the scheduled vote on the proposed tax rate, stating date, place, time and mailing address of the locale. The scheduled meeting at which the tax rate will be decided is September 9, 7:00 p.m., also at the Regents' House.


He continued with a proposal to increase the total tax revenues of the Cisco College Tax District from properties on the tax roll in the preceding year by 5.988%. The total tax revenue proposed to be raised last year at last year's tax rate of \$.2000 for each \$100 of taxable value was \$1,135,067. The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of \$.2000 for each \$100 of taxable value, *excluding* tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$1,203,030. The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of \$.2000 for each \$100 of taxable value, *including* tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$1,207,871.

There was no need for Closed Session.

Regents Ledbetter and Wilcoxon moved and seconded to adjourn. Motion carried.

The 2019 2nd Tax Rate Public Hearing adjourned at 6:03 p.m.
