## Testing Passing Standards - Academic Dual Credit

Students attending Texas public institutions of higher education must be in compliance with the Texas Success Initiative (TSI), in order to enroll in public institutions of higher education. The law requires all entering college students to be assessed for college readiness in reading, mathematics and writing unless the student qualifies for an exemption. The following are approved assessment tests and their corresponding minimum passing standards.
