

## The Testing Center on the Abilene campus offers the HESI A2 for applicants to the Cisco College VN or LVN to AND Bridge programs.

HESI A2 testers must be applicants to the Cisco College nursing program.

Applicants who are unsure of whether they need to take the HESI A2 should check with the Cisco College Nursing Department.

HESI A2 test fees are nonrefundable, and date changes are not allowed after payment if made.

Walk-ins are not accepted for the HESI A2.

### HOW TO SIGN UP FOR THE HESI A2:

1. Applicants must email the Health Sciences counselor ([prehealthsciences@cisco.edu](mailto:prehealthsciences@cisco.edu)) to complete a Program Requirements Checklist prior to signing up for the HESI A2. You may not register for the HESI A2 if you do not meet the minimum requirements for the VN program.
2. Contact the Testing Center by email ([testing@cisco.edu](mailto:testing@cisco.edu)) to confirm that your checklist has been received and that you have been cleared to schedule and pay.
3. Follow the payment instructions in the reply email from the Testing Center. After the Testing Center receives notification of your payment from the Business Office, we will email you a confirmation with important information. PLEASE READ YOUR CONFIRMATION CAREFULLY.
4. Go to [evolve.elsevier.com](http://evolve.elsevier.com) and create a username and password. **Be sure to have this username and password with you on the day you test. You will not be able to create an Evolve account at your test session. Your email is not the same as your username. Please check your Evolve account to make sure that you have the correct username and password.**
5. The HESI A2 test fee is nonrefundable. Due to the high demand for HESI A2, if you miss your scheduled test date, it will be necessary to get special permission to sign up again. If you feel documented, extenuating circumstances have caused you to miss your test date, please see the Health Sciences counselor.
