



ESTIMATED COST OUTLINE

The following cost outline gives an incoming international student an approximate idea of the tuition/fee/room board cost per semester at Cisco College. These rates are subject to change at any time. The international student will also need to allow further expenses on books, supplies, personal items, entertainment, etc. The estimated cost to attend Cisco College for the full 2022-2023 academic year is \$15,000. International students living off campus will need to be prepared for additional expenses.

Tuition

The tuition rate for non-resident/international students enrolled at the Cisco campus is \$191 per semester credit hour plus fees. The tuition rate for non-resident/international students enrolled at the Abilene Educational Center is \$211 per semester credit hour plus fees. All international students are required by immigration to be enrolled full-time. Full-time enrollment is 12 hours

Mandatory Fees

Mandatory Fees include registration, general service, educational service, and records fees. They are included in the chart above.

Lab Fees

Lab fees differ with the different areas of study. Lab fees vary from \$25.00 to \$100.00 per lab course, depending on the nature of the course.

Room and Board Cost (Cisco Campus only)

The average cost for Cisco campus housing and meals for each semester is \$2050 for a total of \$4,100 per academic year. Each student is required to complete a housing reservation application and pay a fee of \$100.

Off Campus Living Expense

Living and personal expenses for international students living off campus is estimated at \$6000 per semester.

Textbooks

Textbooks are available in the Cisco College bookstore. Costs for books and supplies are approximately \$800.00 per academic year.

Insurance

All international students are required to provide proof of health insurance coverage prior to the first class day. Cisco College requires that all international students must have health and accident insurance for the length of time the student is enrolled in classes. The student may not allow health/accident insurance to lapse during their enrollment at Cisco College.

The coverage for health/accident insurance for non-athletic students must be purchased through International Student Protection (ISP).

The coverage for international student athlete health insurance must be purchased through PGH Global/United Healthcare International Student Insurance Plan.

The cost varies based on the plan and length of coverage, at a minimum students should plan on \$500 per fall/spring semester.
